
COVID-19 Vaccinology Videos

Prof. Gary Kobinger (Laval University, Canada) conducted <u>an Audio Interview on "SARS-CoV-2 Vaccine Development: Where Are We Now ?"</u>. During his interview he discussed different vaccines that are currently in development as well as the processes involved in fast-tracking vaccine development in times of an epidemic.

If you conduct any vaccinology research, particularly vaccine development then you should know Prof. <u>Stanley Plotkin!</u>

He also gave a brief history on the vaccine development of different coronaviruses, including initial development of the SARS-CoV (2002/3 epidemic) which was stopped once the epidemic was halted.
